

Bobby and his family personally benefited from social programs that sustained his family during his childhood. He learned the value of hard work and education and will always be thankful for the support that he received in those early years.

Because of his life experience, Bobby has a natural passion for Habitat for Humanity and the mission it serves. He feels a drive and an obligation to do what he can to promote affordable housing in our community. Bobby quickly raised support at First Farmers and Merchants Bank to provide funds for four HFHWM home builds a year in Maury County. We are so thankful for his drive, his passion, and his commitment.
